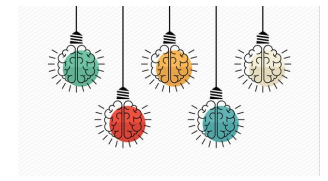


Big Little Activity Kit



Week of:	Supplies	Directions
May 3rd Paper Lantern	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dark Cardstock • Tissue paper • Tea light • Scissors • Glue stick • Pencil 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fold the cardstock into thirds • Draw a design on one of the cardstock thirds. You can also draw shapes inside or the first letter of your name • Cut out your design, be sure not to cut too much because you will need to have some cardstock to glue your tissue paper to. • Glue tissue paper to cover your cutouts, get creative and make it colorful! • Fold the lantern on the lines to form a triangular prism. Be sure to keep the side that you glued the tissue paper to on the inside. • Glue or tape the small fold to the other end of your triangular prism • Place a tea light inside
May 10th Gummy Bear Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gummy bears • Cups • Water and other liquids to experiment with 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fill several cups with different liquids found in your kitchen (some examples: water, vinegar, juice, oil, salt water, soda, etc) • Be sure to leave one gummy bear untouched, this will serve as your control and you can use it to compare the original size to the gummy bears in the liquids • Let the gummy bears sit in the liquids for several hours and watch them grow! • Do you notice any other changes?
May 17th Bubble Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bubble Solution <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contains: water, dish soap, glycerin • Straw • Solid surface (a place that can get wet) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spray or wipe your surface to make it wet • Dip your straw in the bubble solution. • Blow into the straw: You want to almost touch the surface with your straw and slowly pull away while still blowing to make a nice large bubble. • Try making a bubble inside a bubble: Dip your straw in more solution, slowly insert into your first bubble and then blow
